**Re: Swine Flu**

I am writing to let you know that we have had one confirmed and one unconfirmed case of Swine Flu in the recent past within the RHS community. As you will probably be aware, the Government is now advising that schools should not close if they experience an outbreak of Swine Flu. Here at RHS our pupils can be isolated and treated at our own sizeable and well-equipped Health Centre.

I am also writing to inform and reassure you that we do have a contingency plan in place in anticipation of a flu pandemic, and we are monitoring Health Protection Agency advice as events unfold.

In the meantime, I will ensure that all parents, pupils, staff and the school community as a whole are kept informed as appropriate concerning the procedures and actions that we will be taking in the event of an outbreak of Swine Flu.
